## GCSE results August 2017

Congratulations to all of our year 11 students for their well-deserved GCSE results. After their journey through school over recent years and all of the hard work that students have put in, especially in year 11, the long wait for their GCSE results was over.

On 25<sup>th</sup> August 2017 our year 11 students came into school to collect their results, and there were many happy faces! The hard work and dedication of our students and their families and staff have paid off with students achieving a very good set of results.

In a year when the first awards in the new GCSEs in English and Maths were issued we had a number of students who achieved outstanding results. Of note are:

- Callum Ellis who achieved 9 grade A\* equivalents (including the very highest grade available, a grade 9 in English Language) and one grade A
- Olivia Palmer who achieved 5 grade A\* equivalents and 5 grade A equivalents
- Lauren Sabin who achieved 3 grade A\* equivalents, 5 grade a equivalents and 2 grade B equivalents
- Tanitia Moore who achieved 3 grade A\* equivalents (including the very highest grade available, a grade 9 in English Language), 6 grade A equivalents and a grade B and a grade C
- Dellan Oke who achieved 2 A\* equivalents, 5 grade A equivalents and 3 grade B equivalents

In addition the following students all achieved 10 or more qualifications at grade C or higher:

Klaudiusz Marmurowicz, Reece Pendlebury, Charlie Massey, Lucy McGregor, Thomas Clarke, George Galpin, India Rose Avis, Jake Haines, Lucie Heaton, Lewis Salter, Seth Walker, Ryan Rawson and Jack White.

Overall 57% of our students this year achieved a grade 4 (equivalent to a grade C) or higher in both English and Maths. This is a massive 11% improvement on 2016. Also, 53% of our students achieved the equivalent of 5A\*-C including English and Maths, which again is a huge 11% increase on 2016.

I and all the staff at Heritage High School would like to congratulate all of our students for their excellent results, and thank all parents/carers for their ongoing support.
