Christmas Fair

Friday 5th December is the Christmas Fair.

This year, the children will be running their own stalls at their fair prior to the PTA fair opening. This is part of their enterprise work and each class will be working hard to see how much profit they make on the items they have made. The children's stalls will be in the school hall and parents are invited to attend these from 2.30pm before going to the PTA winter fair from 3.00pm (we will close this at around 5pm). Please pick up children from school as normal.

Weather permitting, we are hoping to have a bouncy snowman on the village green. We are hoping to have this from approximately lunchtime on the day and it will be open to all children (and adults!) who wish to have a go. All classes will be allowed time to visit the snowman during the school day. The snowman will be £1 per child for approximately 5 mins of bouncing fun.

From 3pm, in the playground (again weather permitting) and in the Village Hall, we hope to have various stalls and games for you all to enjoy, plus refreshments and a performance by the School Choir. There will also be a chance to see Santa in his grotto, which you can pre-book at the office to guarantee your visit, £2 with a gift and this year you can have a framed photo for £4.

Instead of our normal raffle, this year we are running a 50/50 raffle. The lucky winner will receive 25% of the total raffle takings; there is also a 2nd prize (15% of takings) and a 3rd prize (10% of takings). We have raised £300 so far, and the prize fund is rising all the time. Raffle tickets will also be available at the fair to buy.
