We wanted to make you aware of the following over the coming months:

Cauliflower Cards

Most of you will know that around this time of year, the children complete Christmas card designs in class. These are sent home for you to look at (and add to if you wish). We then, through Cauliflower Cards, offer the opportunity for you to buy the designs as cards and gift labels. £1 from every pack bought goes to the PTA. Please look out for your child's design coming home soon – we have a tight timescale to turn this around and would appreciate it if you could return any orders to school by **Monday 13th October**.

October Disco

Thursday 23rd October is the end of half-term school disco:

Infants 5:45 - 7pm and Juniors 7:15 - 8:30pm

(Year 3 children in the Y2/3 class can choose whether they would like to come to the infant or junior disco).



Entry is £2 and all drinks are free. It is 20p for sweets/crisps/chocolate and we will also be trialling some more expensive items (but nothing more than £1).

Friday 5th December is the Christmas Fair. This will open at 3pm and close around 5pm.

Instead of our normal raffle, this year we are running a 50/50 raffle. The lucky winner will receive 25% of the total raffle takings; there is also a 2nd prize (15% of takings) and a 3rd prize (10% of takings). We are already selling the raffle tickets and they will be sent home in book bags in the near future.
